

Service Title: Paediatric Medic First Aid®

Service Ref: TFA05

Course Duration: Min. 1 ½ Days

TASC Paediatric First Aid is a 'hands on' emergency response care course, with Instructor-supervised practices. This programme teaches appropriate CPR/first aid skills for the care of infants and children. Adult care skills are also demonstrated and practised.

TASC Paediatric First Aid emphasises prevention strategies and development of Essential and Secondary Skills of patient care in a flexible course that can be tailored to your training needs

There are several versions of this course:

- Paediatric Basic Life Supports (4hrs)
- Paediatric First Aid Plus (12 hrs)
- Paediatric First Aids (has the backing of CACHE)
- First Aid in Early Years Settings (approved by the Pre-School Learning Alliance and the National Child-Minding Association)

The course meets the recommendations of the Health & Safety (First Aid) Regulations 1981 issued by the Health & Safety Executive. It is delivered in accordance with the Approved Code of Practice L74 for training of candidates in first aid for low risk environments.

Who would require this service?

Paediatric First Aid makes excellent training for teachers, child care staff, school bus drivers, parents, grandparents and baby sitters. Although not a compulsory requirement, the Health & Safety Executive recommends this course for those who are 'appointed' to take charge of first aid provision if the number of employees and occupational risks are low.

Content:

Candidates will receive training in a wide range of first aid skills including:

- The treatment and priorities of care for an unconscious infant, child and adult
- The treatment of a choking infant, child and adult
- The recognition of respiratory & cardiac arrest and delivery of cardio-pulmonary resuscitation (CPR)
- The ability to safely and promptly treat a patient who is bleeding
- The recognition and treatment of a number of common childhood illnesses

Certification: Candidates who successfully complete the course will be awarded a certificate. The qualification is valid for three years. The course follows a syllabus acceptable to OFSTED etc.
